Here comes the new format of newsletter! We're proud to inform you that:

- The combined evaluation of the European Union's humanitarian interventions is about to be completed. For the record, the evaluation is twofold:
- provide a retrospective assessment of covering the relevance, coherence, (EU) added value, effectiveness, efficiency and sustainability DG ECHO's funded interventions in the "Horn of Africa" AND provide a retrospective assessment of DG ECHO's global programmatic partnership with the ICRC focussing on identifying lessons learned and good practice in Jordan and Colombia
- The creation of a directory and information management system (DIMS) for Civil Society Organizations engaged in the provision of services to affected populations within the Regional Stabilisation Strategy of the Lake Chad Basin is ongoing with the engagement of over 88 Civil Society Organizations.
- R&T is designing and developing a regional human rights approach and programming to counter trafficking in Sudan. Current activities focus on strengthening of civil society organisations to identify, assit and protect victims of trafficking.

PROJECTS UNDERWAY

Roots & Transition maintain its efforts to meet the need for new and flexible solutions and tools in the face of continual changes in the areas of migration and displacement, human trafficking and protection of civilians in emergencies

The following projects are being discussed to come up with solid concept notes:

- Support the fight against trafficking in human beings (THB) and migrant smuggling (MS) in Djibouti and Mauritania: a capacity building courses on human rights protection to counter human trafficking is under discussion.
- Prevention and resolution of agropastoral conflicts in the Sahel. Climate change does drastically change herders' routes and imply land disputes that must be mitigated to avoid escalation in long-lasting conflicts
- The ambitious and promising Great Green Wall project is back on the table. R&T wishes to contribute to combatting desertification through community mobilization and will most probably develop a pilot project in Niger in the near future.
- A partnership is under discussion for the design and implementation of a large Monitoring and Evaluation project in G5 Sahel.
